Currently, in partnerships with credible national organizations, the ICRC is working to bring real and long-term change in the fields of health, physical rehabilitation, mine risk education, restoring family links, promotion of international humanitarian law, and forensics.



In Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, significant developments in our existing partnership with Lady Reading Hospital (LRH) include the establishment of the first ever Nursing Skills Laboratory in Pakistan and a clinic for the treatment of the children with Club Foot deformity. Similarly, the ICRC has also signed a framework

agreement with Khyber Medical University (KMU) to train the healthcare professionals from KP/FATA for the treatment of wounded and sick patients. Together with KMU, the ICRC is also undertaking an in-depth study on the issue of violence against health care in KP in order to find and propose measures to address the issue. Providing physical rehabilitation services to people with physical disabilities is another major area the ICRC is working since 1984. The Physical rehabilitation program is providing services through 16 partners and supporting 25 Physical rehabilitation centers across Pakistan. In 2017, more than 52,000 people with disabilities benefited from the ICRC supported centers in Pakistan.
